We have 10 people on the waiting list at the moment and would like to offer them plots as soon as possible.

Now is the time to prepare your plot if you didn't get a chance to get it sorted before Christmas – the weather did make it difficult for us!

Please ensure that old potatoes and any diseased plants are burned or taken off site for disposal. Leaving them on the plot will cause you and your neighbours problems later this year.

There is a charge of £10 per pole for this service. You will need to ensure your plot is cleared beforehand, with large stones removed prior to rotavation.

Note that more stringent policies are in place for dealing with neglected plots from this year. We know that these cause annoyance to fellow ploholders and are the issue most-raised with the committee.

Caught Short?

Following discussion at the AGMs and efforts of the committee over the last year we are arranging for rental of a portable toilet for use at Marsh Lane.

We plan for it to be delivered in March. Over the next 6 months we will continue to investigate the plausibility of a green toilet solution for the site.

This will make life easier for some of us! No more dashing home mid-work session!
